23 (5) the procedures to be used to ensure the competency of those completing didactic and psychomotor skills training: 24 (6) identification of the learning management system to be used during the course; and 25 (7) identification of each program's quality assurance plan that at a minimum shall include 26 the following: 27 (A) An advisory committee that includes the program coordinator, program medical adviser. 28 and representatives of the following: 29 (i) Current students; 30 (ii) former students; 31 (iii) graduates; 32 (iv) employees; 33 (v) faculty; 34 (vi) all communities of interest; and 35 (vii) local ambulance service; 36 (B) an advisory committee meeting schedule; and 37 (C) a copy of the evaluation tools to be completed by the students, employees, staff, faculty, 38 medical adviser, and program coordinator. 39 (d) Any approved class may be monitored by the executive director or the executive 40 director's designee.
