How do I gain EMS certification in Kansas?

- STEP 1 Find a Kansas approved initial course
- STEP 2 Successfully complete that initial course
- STEP 3 7 or more days after the date of last class and no later than 24 months after Step 2 was completed - Pass both State Certifying Examinations within 12 months of each other.

Skills Exam (EMR/EMT – up to 4 attempts; AEMT/Paramedic – up to 2 full attempts) and Knowledge Exam (All levels – up to 6 attempts)

STEP 4 - Submit a fingerprint card, waiver, and \$50 fee to KBEMS for criminal history record check.

Can skip Step 4 if previously EMS certified in Kansas at any level

- 1. Login to the Portal
- 2. Click on "Applications" on left hand side
- 3. Click on "View My Applications"
- 4. Find "Criminal History Records Check Waiver Application" and click "Apply Now"
- 5. Complete the application and submit follow the emailed instructions

STEP 5 - Be at least 17 years of age

After completing steps 2 through 5, make application for certification

- 3. Click on "View My Applications"
- 4. Find "Initial EMS Provider Certification Application" and click "Apply Now"
- 5. Complete the application and submit (will need to pay the application fee as well) EMR - \$15 EMT or AEMT - \$50 Paramedic - \$65

Incomplete applications not corrected or not paid in full within 15 days will be denied. Effective: December 31, 2021
