3. Meeting Notes, Decisions, Issues

- January MAC Meeting Notes
 - No changes requested Approved as provided
- Old Business
 - Position statement Rapid Sequence Intubation
 - Members discussed the RSI position statement drafted by Dr. Allin.
 - Dr. Allin noted that two position statements have been drafted, one addressing only RSI and one addressing prehospital endotracheal



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intubation.

- Dr. Jacobsen commented that the RSI position statement offers a straight forward approach to services performing rapid sequence intubation. The statement does not dictate to services how to do it however it provides guidance on the important issues of medical direction, training, resources and quality review.
- Dr. Jacobsen noted a few wordsmithing changes and will forward these to Dr. Allin.
- Decision was made to present a final draft for approval at the May MAC meeting.
- Members discussed the MAC position statement on prehospital endotracheal intubation. Members were in agreement that the position statement on RSI addresses the MAC position on prehospital intubation. Suggestion was made to not attempt a broader statement as a whole at this time.
- Decision was made to table action on the position statement on prehospital endotracheal intubation.

New Business

- o FLEX EMS Update
 - Members were asked for input on training opportunities they believe would be beneficial for EMS medical advisors.
 - Discussion ensued on a forum for medical advisors to meet periodically to address common issues in Kansas EMS. Topics of interest included information sharing, benchmarking, quality outcomes and additional information on the statewide forum for data registry.
 - Dr. Longabaugh will follow up with Gilbert Tabares on the amount of funding available and provide this information to the members.
- Scope of Practice Question
 - Dr. Jacobsen presented a question received by board staff regarding the scope of practice of an AEMT. Specifically, can an AEMT, if trained to do so, access a PICC line, monitor fluids infusing and administer medications through a PICC line?
 - Discussion ensued on the accepted techniques, complications if the line is not working, flushing the line, education, training and protocol components.
 - Dr. Allin noted the only drug requiring a dose change would be Adenosine
 - Consensus from the members was to allow a trained AEMT to access, monitor and administer medications through a PICC line.
 - Motion was made, seconded and passed to allow an AEMT to access a



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PICC line as part of their scope of practice.
